M-TH 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

F-SAT 10:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

SUN 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Rules While Utilizing the Pool

1. Respect and obey the lifeguards
2. No running, pushing, shoving, dunking or horseplay
3. No gum
4. No glass anywhere in pool area
5. No pets
6. No tobacco or e-cigarettes
7. No food or beverages allowed in or at the edge of the pool
8. Rafts and floats are allowed at lifeguards' discretion
9. Radio/music is allowed at lifeguards' discretion and should be appropriate for all audiences
10. Children must be accompanied by an adult or caregiver at least 16 years of age
11. Adult swim/10-minute rest period will occur at the end of each hour
12. Zero depth pool is reserved for toddlers and preschoolers who must always be directly supervised by a caregiver. Older children may not use this pool during adult swim.
13. Children not fully toilet trained and/or under the age of 3 must wear a swim diaper
14. All accidents must be reported to the lifeguards immediately
15. Babies and toddlers in/on floatation devices must be within arm's reach of a caregiver
16. Swimmers must dry off and wear shoes when entering the Meeting House
17. Pool will close if the air temperature is below 70 degrees
18. Pool will close when thunder and/or lightening occur. Pool will re-open at guard's discretion.
19. Please help keep the pool area and rest rooms clean. Properly dispose of all trash.



20. The pool in Stonegate is for the sole use of Stonegate Property Owners and their supervised guests. All guests must be accompanied by a Property Owner when visiting the pool. All Property Owners must use their issued pass card and/or sign in when entering the pool area.

21. Per the Boone County Health Dept: Covid Capacity Rules are as follows:

Blue – 100 percent capacity

Yellow – 50 percent capacity

Orange – 25 percent capacity

Red – up to 25 percent capacity

(yellow to red: you will be asked to sign in and out to track capacity)

22. Per the Boone County Health Dept: Every 3-5 Hours pool furniture will need to be sanitized by staff. Plan on taking a short break from using the furniture each afternoon for proper cleaning.

23. The Boone County Health Dept encourages the use of masks when entering and exiting the pool deck. Please be mindful of crowding and maintain social distancing.

24. You will not be allowed to enter the pool area if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, including fever, cough, GI issues, etc. You must be symptom free for at least 10 days before returning to the pool. Please do not take this lightly as exposing others at the pool is incredibly irresponsible.
